**Early Intervention Coordinating Council (EICC) Parent Recruitment**

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Dear Colleague:

The Early Intervention Coordinating Council (EICC) is an advisory council to the Bureau of Early Intervention. It is comprised of 30 members who represent the various Early Intervention Program (EIP) stakeholders, including parents, providers, municipalities, and other State agencies. The EICC meets quarterly, usually once in March, June, September, and December. The meetings are from 10:15am-3pm, with a half-hour lunch break, and are held in Albany, with videoconferencing locations in Rochester and New York City. The meetings are held virtually if there is a state of emergency.

We are currently looking for up to two parents to join the Council. The parents will need to be the parent of a child who is six years or younger with a developmental delay or disability and will provide a diverse perspective and is interested in improving the EIP for all families.

Please note that if the parent is approved and makes it to the vetting process, it could take up to two years and will include additional paperwork and a full background check for the Governor's office to appoint them. **Please let the parent know the deadline for submission is 1/31/2022.**
